Brahms: Ach, arme welt 9th Mar

Ah, thou false world, thou art not true, thy glories fade, I know and rue, with grief and sorrow try me. The honours, riches, thou hast brought, in death, in dire distress are naught; Thy treasure vain and falsely wrought. Lord, give me peace eternal.

Parry: Dear Lord and Father of mankind 9th Mar

Byrd: Civitas sancti tui 16th Mar
(Translation from Latin) Your holy city has become a wilderness. Zion has become a wilderness, Jerusalem has been made desolate.

Walton: A Litany 23rd Mar
Drop, drop, slow tears, and bathe those beautiful feet, which brought from heaven the news and Prince of Peace. Cease not, wet eyes, his mercies to entreat; to cry for vengeance sin doth never cease. In your deep floods drown all my faults and fears; nor let his eye see sin, but through my tears.

Lindley: Ave Maria 30th Mar
(Translation from Latin) Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Queen of heaven sweet and merciful, O Mother of God, pray for us sinners, that with the elect we may gaze upon thee.

Stainer: God so loved the world 13th Apr
God so loved the world that he sent his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved.

Eaton: Procession to Jerusalem 31st Mar
And it came to pass that many were come to Jerusalem for the feast of the Passover. And when they heard that Jesus was coming they went forth to meet him. And many spread their garments in the way: and some cut down branches of palm trees, and strewed them in the way. And the multitude cried with loud voice, "Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest!"

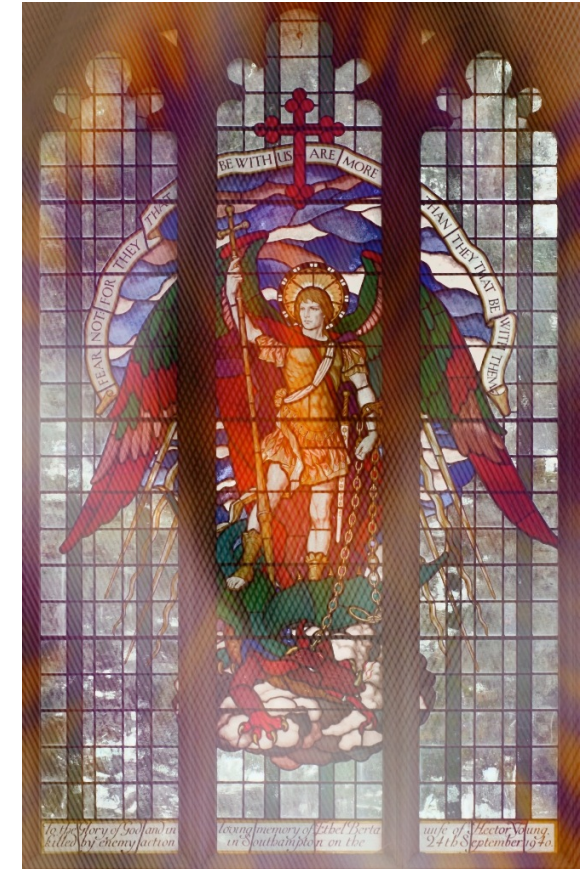
Duruflé: Tantum ergo 28th Mar

Jubilant praise, glory, laud, honor, and benediction be to the Father and the Son. Equal praise be to Him that proceeds from the two.

Wood: Hail gladdening light! 30th Mar
