9 <sup>th</sup> December	324, Hill Lane	Unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given (Isaiah 9:6-7)	
10 <sup>th</sup> December 	1, Highclere Road	God sent the angel Gabriel to a virgin who lived in Nazareth, a town in Galilee. Her name was Mary. (Luke 1:26-27) The angel said to Mary, “You will become pregnant. You will give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus.” (Luke 1:31-33)	
11 <sup>th</sup> December	Northern end of Pointout Road	Mary got up and went quickly to stay with her cousin Elizabeth, who said, “God has blessed you more than any other woman.”(Luke 1:39-42)	
12 <sup>th</sup> December	Lordswood Road opp. Malwood Avenue. If driving, don't park in Lordswood Close, "Private Road"!	Mary was engaged to marry Joseph. An angel appeared to Joseph to tell him that the baby Mary was going to have was God's Son. (Matthew 1:18-24)	
13 <sup>th</sup> December	35, Butterfield Road	At that time, Augustus Caesar sent an order to all people in the countries that were under Roman rule. And everyone went to their own towns to register. (Luke 2:1-3) So Joseph left Nazareth, a town in Galilee. He went to the town of Bethlehem in Judea with Mary, who was expecting a child. (Luke 2: 4-5)	
14 <sup>th</sup> December 	3 <sup>rd</sup> on right from top of Winchester Road	While Joseph and Mary were in Bethlehem, the time came for her to have the baby. She gave birth to her first son. There were no rooms left in the inn. So, she wrapped the baby with cloths and laid him in a box where animals feed. (Luke 2:6-7)	
15 <sup>th</sup> December	34, Copperfield Road	That night, some shepherds were in the fields nearby watching their sheep. (Luke 2:8)	
16 <sup>th</sup> December 	8, Copperfield Road	An angel of the Lord stood before them. The glory of the Lord was shining around them, and suddenly they became very frightened. (Luke 2:9) The angel said to them, “Don't be afraid, because I am bringing you some good news. It will be a joy to all the people. Today your Saviour was born in David's town. He is Christ, the Lord. This is how you will know him: you will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a feeding box.” (Luke 2:10-12) Then a very large group of angels from heaven joined the first angel. All the angels were praising God, saying, “Give glory to God in heaven, and on earth let there be peace.” (Luke 2:13-14)

17 <sup>th</sup> December	420, Winchester Road	Then the angels left the shepherds and went back to heaven. (Luke 2:16) Then the shepherds went back to their sheep, praising God and thanking him for everything that they had seen and heard. It was just as the angel had told them. (Luke 2:20)	
18 <sup>th</sup> December	Opposite Greenwoods shop. High Road	When Jesus was a few weeks old, Joseph and Mary took him to the temple in Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. Simeon and Anna, two very old and faithful people, met Jesus and realised he was God’s Chosen King. They told everyone about him. (Luke 2:22-38)	
19 <sup>th</sup> December	Left fork of Bassett Close	After Jesus was born, a star appeared in the east. (Matthew 2:2)	
20 <sup>th</sup> December	2, Fernlea Gardens	Wise men from the east saw the star, and went to Jerusalem, following the star. They had a secret meeting with King Herod in the palace. (Matthew 2:1) The wise men left the palace and followed the star to the place where Jesus, Mary, and Joseph were staying. (Matthew 2:9)	
21 <sup>st</sup> December	331, Woodmill Lane, Swaythling 	They saw the child, Jesus, with his mother, Mary. They bowed down and worshipped the child. (Matthew 2:11a) They opened the gifts they had brought for him. They gave him treasures of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. (Matthew 2:11b)	
22 <sup>nd</sup> December	103, Ethelburt Avenue	God warned the wise men in a dream not to go back to Herod. So, they went back to their own country another way. (Matthew 2:12)	
23 <sup>rd</sup> December	Oak Corner 54, Channels Farm Road Southampton	After they left, an angel of the Lord came to Joseph in a dream. The angel said, “Get up! Take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Herod will start looking for the child to kill him. Stay in Egypt until I tell you to return.” (Matthew 2:13-14)	
24 <sup>th</sup> December	St Michael’s or All Saints’ Churches	The Word became a human being and lived among us (John 1:14)
