- 1 Happy the one whose transgression ¹ is for¹ given, ♦
and ¹ whose ¹ sin is ¹ covered.
- 2 Happy the one to whom the Lord im¹putes no ¹ guilt, ♦
and in whose ¹ spirit there ¹ is no ¹ guile.
- 3 For I ¹ held my ¹ tongue; ♦
my bones wasted away
through my ¹ groaning ¹ all the day ¹ long.
- 4 Your hand was heavy upon me ¹ day and ¹ night; ♦
my moisture was dried up ¹ like the ¹ drought in ¹ summer.
- 5 Then I acknowledged my ¹ sin to ¹ you ♦
and my in¹iquity I ¹ did not ¹ hide.
- 6 I said, 'I will confess my transgressions ¹ to the ¹ Lord,' ♦
and you for¹gave the ¹ guilt of my ¹ sin.
- 7 Therefore let all the faithful make their prayers to you
in ¹ time of ¹ trouble; ♦
in the great ¹ water flood, it ¹ shall not ¹ reach them.

whose mouths must be held with bit and bridle,
or else they ' will not ' stay ' near you.'

shout for joy, ' all who are ' true of ' heart.
