Some people have voiced concerns about Communion especially as there are some nasty flu bugs around just now. The advice of our Bishops is that the risk of infection from the chalice is low but if any individual is concerned, then it is perfectly valid to receive communion in only one kind (either bread or wine) The practice of intinction (dipping the wafer in the wine) carries risks of a communicant inadvertently contaminating the wine for the next person and is no more hygienic than simply taking a sip from the chalice. Please talk to Sheena if you are concerned about this.
