- 1 Why are the ' nations in ' tumult, ♦  
and why do the peoples de'vise a ' vain ' plot?
- 2 The kings of the earth rise up,  
and the rulers take ' counsel to'gether, ♦  
against the Lord ' and a'gainst his a'nointed:
- 3 'Let us break their ' bonds a'sunder ♦  
and ' cast a'way their ' cords from us.'
- 4 He who dwells in heaven shall ' laugh them to ' scorn; ♦  
the Lord shall ' have them ' in de'risión.
- 5 Then shall he speak to them ' in his ' wrath ♦  
and ' terrify them ' in his ' fury:
- 6 'Yet have I ' set my ' king ♦  
upon my ' holy ' hill of ' Zion.'
- 7 I will proclaim the de'cree of the ' Lord; ♦  
he said to me: 'You are my Son; this ' day have ' I be'gotten you.
